The enhancement was undertaken by Mark Vigrass Ltd at a cost of £1917.

Site description:
A classic chalk stream with bank damage caused by cattle accessing the river to drink.

Special considerations:
Work undertaken adjacent to a public footpath. Care and consideration needed.

Completed project:

- 130m of fencing to restrict livestock access.
- Dilapidated stile replaced with hand gate to improve public access for all.

Benefits:

- Reduced bank damage, limiting the amount of sediment entering the system.
- Improved habitat for marginal plant species.
- Improved public access for all.
