Details : This is a practical conservation workday on the Waithe beck at the beautiful Moorhouse Farm in the north of the Lincolnshire Wolds. The work will involve clearing the banks of the chalk stream as well as raking sediment off the bed. The purpose is to improve the habitat for all kinds of water loving creatures, such as water voles and brown trout. If it's safe to do so there'll also be a chance to do a bit of basic surveying to identify some of the invertebrates that are so vital to life around and in Lincolnshire's chalk streams.
