Details : Practical conservation day near Cuxwold

A previous restoration site, this beautiful part of the Swallow beck needs a little helping hand to keep it flowing. In the summer months it gets clogged up with too much weed so we're going to be removing some to aid flow.

If safe to do so, there may also be time to do a stream dip where we may conduct a basic survey for stream invertebrates, vital to the chalk streams ecosystem.

Please wear suitable clothing i.e. long trousers and long sleeved top, and bring waterproofs just in case! Suitable footwear is essential - wellies or a sturdy pair of walking boots. If you've got waders please bring them along! Please bring a pack lunch and a drink.
